

Never Alone

One of my favorite Hymn, is Never Alone, it is a powerful song in my spiritual life. The question I would like to address today is why should I feel alone in this world.

Loneliness is a serious problem in the lives of millions. Salomon wrote, “*You are better off to have a friend than to be all alone, because then you will get more enjoyment out of what you earn. If you fall, your friend can help you up. But if you fall without a friend nearby, you are really in trouble.*” *Ecclesiastes 4:9,10*

People suffer all kind of loneliness problem, when I say people it does not exclude Christians, some take drugs, adventures into sexual immorality, join a gang, drinking alcohol, some even attempt suicide, because they feel rejected in a world they were born in. Even servants of God sometimes feel discouraged, in Psalms 42: 3, we read, *day and night my tears are my only food, as everyone keeps asking, where is your God, verse 6 I am deeply discouraged as I think about you from where the Jordan begins at Mount Hermon and from Mount Mizar.*

It is ironic to think that a world with six billions people in it, have so many people living in fear of loneliness. The problem is not a lack of people for scientists are already complaining that the world is overcrowded. In fact you may even have so many friends in you organizers and still feel lonely.

In order to have a clear understanding of our world population from a Christian perspective, we need to go in the last book of the bible, for a deeper search.
